

## **Battle Ground School District**

Despite recent large increases in spending, public school officials are not providing children with the high-quality education they promised.

1. Number of students: 13,092

2. Number of schools: 23

3. Spending per student: \$14,900<sup>1</sup>

4. Spending on teacher pay:

Average teacher gets \$109,100 in pay and benefits.

Teachers can make up to \$124,000 in pay and benefits.

5. Spending on central office staff:

Superintendent gets \$248,400 in salary, plus \$56,100 in benefits.

Number of administrators paid over \$100,000 a year: 69.

Only 53 percent of employees are teachers.


6. Spending growth:

Per-student spending has increased by \$4,500, or 45 percent, in six years.

## 7. Student learning<sup>2</sup>

2018-19:

- 41.3 percent of students fail to meet state standard in English
- 52.7 percent of students fail to meet state standard in math
