Despite recent large increases in spending, public school officials are not providing children with the high-quality education they promised.

- 1. Number of students: 15,829
- 2. Number of schools: 20
- 3. Spending per student: \$17,400<sup>1</sup>
- 4. Spending on teacher pay:

Average teacher gets \$128,360 in pay and benefits.

Teachers can make up to \$150,800 in pay and benefits.

## 5. Spending on central office staff:

Superintendent gets \$326,600 in salary, plus \$72,300 in benefits.

Number of administrators paid over \$100,000 a year: 66.

Only 52 percent of employees are teachers.

## 6. Spending growth:


Per-student spending has increased by \$6,900, or 66 percent, in six years.
