Despite recent large increases in spending, public school officials are not providing children with the high-quality education they promised.

- 1. Number of students: 9,683
- 2. Number of schools: 15
- 3. Spending per student: \$16,100¹
- 4. Spending on teacher pay:

Average teacher gets \$133,100 in pay and benefits.

Teachers can make up to \$139,000 in pay and benefits.

5. Spending on central office staff:

Superintendent gets \$260,900 in salary, plus \$62,200 in benefits.

Number of administrators paid over \$100,000 a year: 50.

Only 51 percent of employees are teachers.

6. Spending growth:


Per-student spending has increased by \$6,300, or 64 percent, in six years.
